Public sector assignments in developing countries have been a major area of work: preparing and appraising development and investment plans for individual projects or complete sectors, and advising on related managerial, institutional, financial and operational policies particularly with regard to pricing and regulation. Sectoral experience has included transport, energy, tourism, construction and property. Roads and road transport have been a particular speciality and this has entailed many assignments working in multi-disciplinary teams with civil engineers, environmentalists and other specialists.

Although these projects have been sectorally oriented, macroeconomic reviews have been a regular component, since sectoral plans and projects necessitate an appreciation of economic growth prospects as a basis for forecasting future demand whether it be energy, construction materials or traffic and transport.

Published work has included regular contributions to the EIU's various quarterly publications (Motor Business, Country Reports and Energy Reviews), and, as EIU special reports, a report on the UK construction sector; a country review and macro-economic analysis for Egypt; and a review of the UK commercial property sector.
