John Pratt is an independent UK-based trade-and-environment, agriculture, and rural development consultant. He works in project identification, formulation and preparation, programme planning and budgeting, start-up management and mid-term/ex post evaluations. His principal areas of technical expertise are Environmental aspects of Trade, Value Chain Analysis, Marketing Development and Enterprise Economics.

He has spent the last four years on assignments in Tanzania, Kenya, Ethiopia, Papua New Guinea and the Caribbean (CARIFORUM States). He worked in Russia (TACIS 1993-94) on wholesale market development and related food supply chain support. From 1995 to 2006 he was involved in enterprise development initiatives and investment for rural livelihoods improvement in Swat and other Districts in Northern Pakistan (horticulture) and Malawi (honey, tree seed oils, fisheries and aquaculture).
